



Enrollment in CUHSD as an International Exchange Student

To enroll as a foreign exchange student in the Campbell Union High School District (CUHSD), the student must:

1. Work through an approved Foreign Exchange student organization
2. Enroll in our district for a full academic year and reside with a family who lives in the appropriate attendance area
3. Submit a completed application (prepared by the Foreign Exchange student organization) during the designated Open Enrollment period (i.e., approximately February of the school year preceding the intended year of enrollment as a foreign exchange student)

Please note:

1. There are only a limited number of “slots” for foreign exchange students at each site; this number is determined each year **based on enrollment projections** for the upcoming year.
2. The district begins processing applications received during the Transfer Request period, December 1 through January 1 with notifications going out in March for the upcoming year. Late applications will be process on an “upon receipt”.
3. There are no fees due to the district for the school year during which the student is enrolled as an international exchange student.
4. There are typically fees due to the International Exchange student organization.
5. A student may only be enrolled in CUHSD for one year as an international exchange student.
