**NEW FOR NEXT YEAR!**

Thank you to everyone who came out to the parent meeting last night. Here is a recap:

- We are immediately launching a referral program for our next school year. For every family you refer to St. Pius V, you will become eligible for a \$500 credit toward your own tuition. Terms of the program are available in the office. We will also send them home and post them on the website very soon.
- If you have a family (or families) who may be interested in St. Pius V, please bring them to Open House on May 9<sup>th</sup>. Also, we have information packets that you may like to share with others. The packets are available in the office.
- Our financial status is much stronger and we want to keep it that way in order to provide a Christ-centered education to as many families as possible. To that end, we have teamed with the Diocese of Orange to strengthen our finances. In the beginning of May, members of the Diocese of Orange team will begin meeting with families who have applied for tuition assistance through FACTS. Each family will be given an appointment to talk with our diocesan representatives. If you plan to apply for tuition assistance for the 2018-19 school year, please do so as soon as possible.
- Next year the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade will be included in the 1:1 technology program. All students in grades 2-8 will be using their own personal Chromebooks. Families may purchase their Chromebooks from any vendor (Target, Walmart, Amazon, etc.) More information is included in this family packet.
- Please be sure to get your Summer School registration in to us as soon as possible so that we can effectively and efficiently plan materials and classes. Information was sent home in a previous family folder and is available in the office and on-line.
- In June, Dr. Bravo will be calling for a gathering of parents interested in helping with ideas and implementation of fundraising activities. Look for her email in June...but start thinking about it now!
