- Students are not permitted to take a final exam early. An absence on Tuesday, July 17 will result in a zero for the final exam.
- Students will not earn course credit if absent more than three times during a five-week course.
- All Summer School books must be purchased prior to the first day of classes.
- The *Introduction to High School English/Freshmen Orientation* course is intended to give incoming freshmen helpful tools and a means of practical preparation for high school (e.g., athletics, extra-curricular opportunities, classroom requirements, scheduling, and lockers). The course is designed to help students become acclimated to campus, improve study and note-taking skills, and practice time-management and organization.
