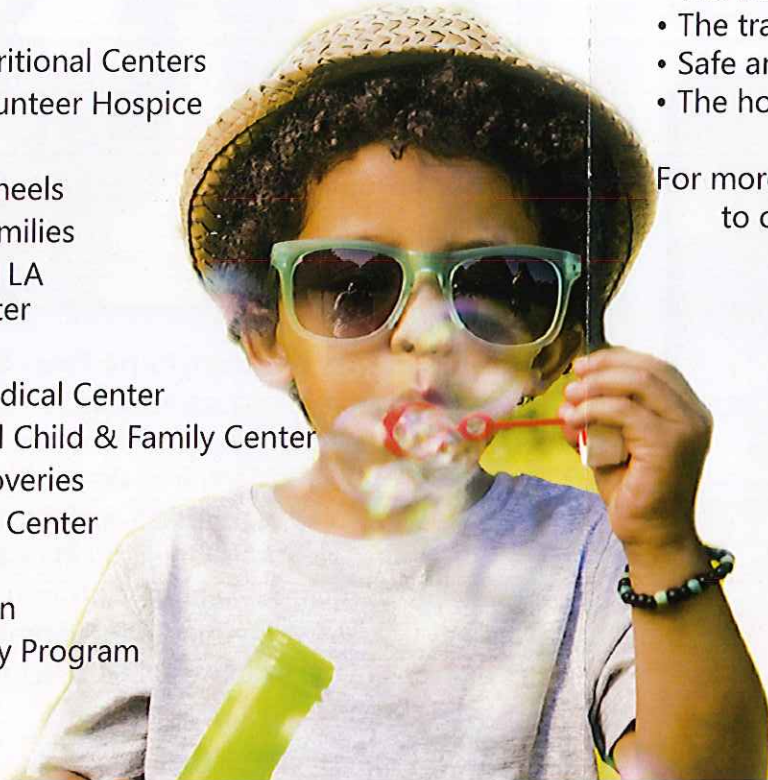

- The honoring of all voices of our community

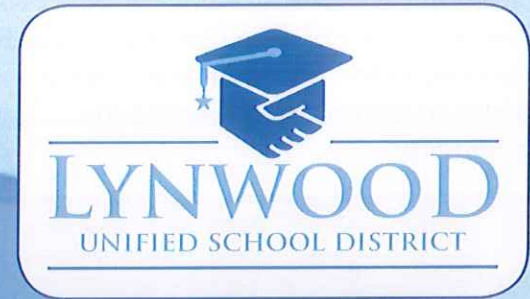

Mental Health Services

Lynwood Unified School District provides students and their families with emotional and mental health services to ensure their success in academics and life.



School & Transition Assistance for

Youngsters (STAY) provides homeless youths and families with academic support, community services and resources, food bank referrals, housing, employment, health care, transportation and mental health services.



Foster Youth Services

Lynwood Unified supports foster students with academic support, transportation, mentoring, academic/career planning, job connections, mental health services and workshops for foster parents.

The Health Collaborative Connection

1. Students/families meet with a school counselor or administrator to discuss specific needs.
2. School counselors/administrators complete the Health Collaborative referral and obtain parent authorization. Referrals and the student's medical card are emailed to the Student Services Department.
3. Licensed Clinical Social Workers (LCSWs) screen referrals and refer students to partnering agencies in our Health Collaborative.
4. LCSWs confirm receipt and processing of the referral with the student's school and parent.
5. Health Collaborative partners contact parents within three weeks to begin the intake process. Emergency/crisis situations receive services within 72 hours.



Health Services

Through the Health Insurance enrollment process, students who do not have health insurance are referred to a Health Collaborative partner to enroll in a program that meets their needs. Through these partners, students and families receive medical care such as vision, dental and immunization services. Health care workshops for parents are held throughout the district. Workshops include nutrition and exercise, diabetes control, children's physical fitness and domestic violence.



Young Parent & Pregnant Teen Support

Resources for young parents and pregnant teens include free childcare referrals to Health Collaborative partners, free diapers and wipes, special needs item requests such as car seats, high-chairs, playpens, etc. Educational support workshops include Healthy Nutrition & Parenting, Father's Role, Career Planning, Parenting & Self-Esteem, Financial Literacy, Post-Partum Care and Co-Parenting.
