

Chromebook 101 for Home

This year, the Henderson County Board of Education has provided your child with an outstanding opportunity! The school board is providing all middle school students with a chrome book to help aid in their learning experience. Once students complete a digital citizenship course, they will bring the devices home. Our target is that students will bring them home by Fall Break. There is a \$25 usage fee for the device.

Protect Yourself: It is important that students stay on approved sites, keep their passwords private, do not give out any personal information, and log off when they are done.

Insurance: All devices are insured for accidental damage. Insurance does not cover theft/loss. If a device, charger, and/or case is lost it is the parent's responsibility to pay the replacement fee. In the event that a student intentionally damages a device, there will be a repair fee to fix the device.

Helpful Tips: Here is some helpful information and tips to help with the usage of chrome books at home.

- Students are responsible for their chrome books at all time.
- Students are to charge their device nightly.
- Students are to bring their chrome book to school every day.
- Please keep food and drinks away from the devices at all times.
- Please keep devices away from small children and pets.
- If you discover that a device is broken or lost, please alert the school immediately.



How Will the Chrome Books be Used at Home:

Students have the potential of a wide range of assignments on their chrome book. Most will be assignments that can be completed off-line (requiring no internet access) and from time-to-time, they may have assignments that need internet access. If you do not have internet access at home, these students could use the school internet in homework help before school or during intervals throughout the school day. We are so excited about this learning opportunity for your child.
