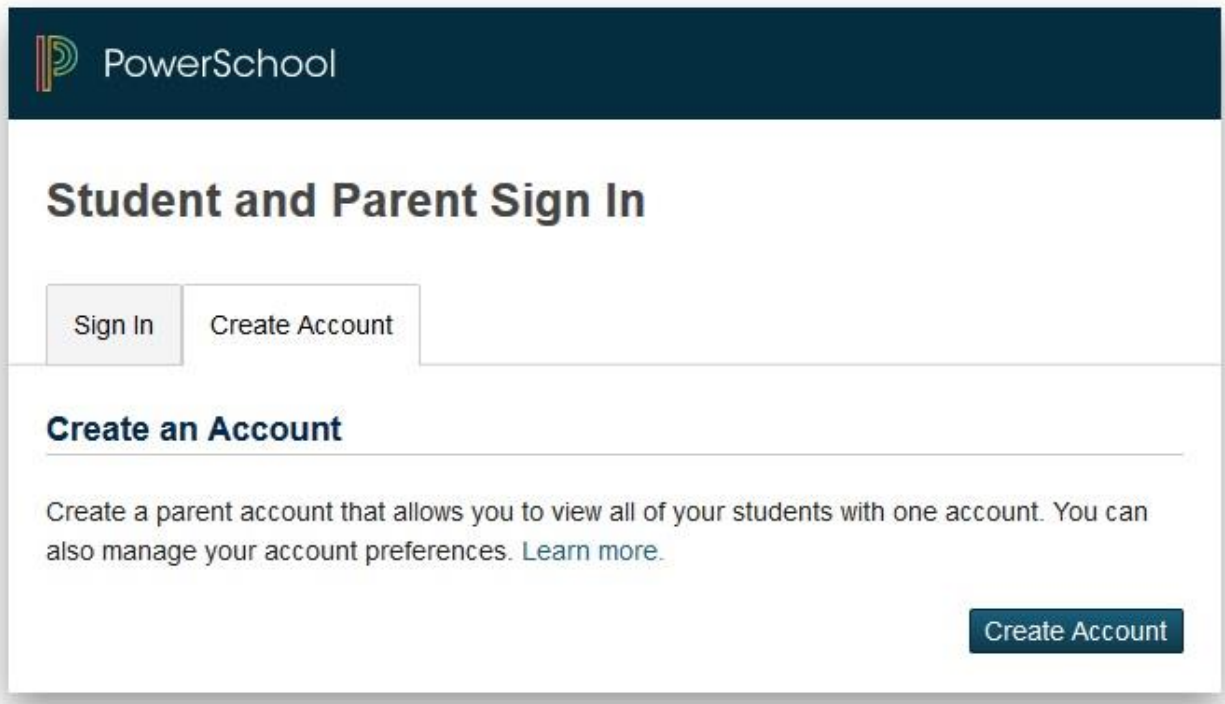


Starting with PS v 9.0, PowerSchool is enforcing the “single sign on” for parents. It involves one initial setup, but then lets parents with multiple students in the district see all their children with one logon... thus the name.

The setup is initiated by going to the second tab on the Student / Parent login screen, then pressing the Create Account button;



This gives a screen where the parent creates their own unique ID and PW, and enters information (including the PS IDs and PWs issued for each student). After this is completed, parents use THEIR logons, not the PS ID and PW for each child.
