4. The Board reviewed student release information for students being released to other school systems.
5. Cell Phone Policy Update – Mr. McDonald presented the Board with two options with regards to the cell phone policy. He discussed feedback that he had received from principals with regard to these two options. Mr. Brown asked Wayne Price what kind of policy could be enforced. Mr. Price indicated he could enforce the current policy but feels the consequences were not stern enough. Mr. Brown asked that the high school principals, Wayne Price and Danyelle Parker, look at the consequences and see what level they wanted to establish. It was discussed that the policy should be consistent in grades 7-12. Mr. Brown also asked that the middle school principals, Kelly Mabe and Rick Swaim, be included in this discussion. Mr. Brown indicated that if all could agree on the policy and consequences to bring to the October Board Meeting as an action item. The K-6 cell phone issues will be discussed at a later time.
6. The Board reviewed fundraiser requests.
7. The Board reviewed contracts/purchases. There was some discussion at the cost of calculators being purchase at the Yadkin Early College.
8. Dr. Benfield discussed the current student enrollment compared to enrollment at the end of the 08-09 school year. There was discussion concerning the drop in enrollment. Mr. McDonald indicated this was the projected number for Yadkin County from the Department of Public Instruction.
9. Mr. Brown asked for a Forbush Middle School Update. Dr. Benfield indicated they are in the process of scheduling a meeting with the contractors to ensure that we could obtain a certificate of occupancy by October 1. Donald Hawks informed the Board that the plans

were to begin waxing floors on October 7 so that furniture could be delivered on October 15.

10. Dr. Benfield gave a report on the opening of Starmount Middle School. He informed the Board that everything has been positive and that the students and staff were excited. He indicated that EC and ESL classes have begun and the core academics were going well. It was the hope of Rick Swaim that the clubs could begin on September 2. Mr. McDonald indicated he had attended a Barnard Trust meeting and they were going to allow Yadkin County Schools to use the \$18,000.00 that had originally been planned for a roof at the CDR for media materials, and that hopefully in January they could allocate money to Forbush Middle for media materials. Dr. Benfield discussed the traffic issues that were occurring at Starmount Middle and High. He indicated the morning traffic was going well; however, the traffic was continuing to back up in the afternoons. Mr. Brown asked Rickey Oakes to look into the traffic issue. Mr. Baity asked about visitor parking in the front of the school and the need to make sure those spots were left available for visitors/parents. Dr. Benfield thanked Donald Hawks and his staff for all their hard work and extra hours to ensure Starmount Middle could open on time. Dr. Benfield also indicated Rick Swaim and his staff has done an excellent job in getting the classrooms ready for students.
11. Mr. McDonald presented an update on employee recalls. He indicated that there had been a reduction in force of 36 teaching positions and all but 7 had been called back, and all but 12 of the 23 teacher assistants had been recalled. He hopes to be able to recall 5 more teacher assistants in the next few days. Mr. McDonald indicated teacher assistants would be called back based on seniority.
12. The joint meeting of the Board of Education and the County Commissioners will be held on Monday, September 28, 2009 at 6:00p.m. This meeting will be hosted by the Board of Education at Starmount Middle School.
13. The Board reviewed the September schedule of activities.
14. Gale Hill gave the Board an update on how Yadkin County Schools would fund the \$918,073.00 that must be reverted to the State. She indicated that the plan was to give up 16.88 teaching positions. These positions were based on an average teacher's salary which is at a higher rate than beginning teachers. Ms. Hill indicated that the reversion of funds in this matter would actually generate money for Yadkin County Schools. Dr. Brown asked Ms. Hill to email her this information. Mr. Dezern asked about the lottery money and Ms. Hill indicated this money is already obligated.

Board Members' Comments:

Steven Hemric, Starmount Student Representative – Steven had concerns over the new principal taking away all breaks at Starmount High School. He indicated that academically and athletically this is a problem due to the fact students are not getting to eat and drink as much. He stated that students are tired and that the athletes are dropping weight due to dehydration. In addition, he feels that the school has to be losing money from the cafeteria by not having a morning break. Steven did inform the Board that the afternoon break was not needed. He stated that he would like to see the morning break reinstated. Dr. Benfield will mention Steven's comments to Ms. Parker and he encouraged Steven to speak with Ms. Parker regarding his concerns. Mr. Brown indicated he will follow-up with Steven at the next Board meeting to see how things are going with regards to breaks.

Diane Hampton – Ms. Hampton expressed concerns regarding Steven Hemric's comments. She recommended that students be allowed to eat and drink. She also asked about the possibility of placing hand sanitizers in

strategic locations at all schools due to the H1N1 Flu. Mr. Brown asked that information be provided at the next Board meeting on the cost of this. Wayne Price, Principal-Forbush High, indicated he had checked into doing this and had found the cost to be \$13.00 each.

Larry Vestal – Mr. Vestal indicated he had toured Starmount Middle School and was very pleased with the way the school turned out. He questioned whether the Board should walk through Forbush Middle School before we take possession of the building.
