GIFTS FROM SCHOOL CONNECTED ORGANIZATIONS

The Bordentown Regional Board of Education appreciates the efforts of groups of parents and other concerned citizens who form "Booster" clubs to support the activities of district-approved student extracurricular programs. The board feels that the focus of these groups should be mainly for moral support as opposed to financial. Gifts and donations from school connected organizations shall be according to the following guidelines:

- A. Fundraising events organized by parent organizations (booster clubs, PTA, PTO, etc.) for approved programs shall qualify for free use of school facilities according to board policy 1330 Use of School Facilities;
- B. Gifts purchased through funds raised by these groups for donation to the school district must have prior approval in accordance with the following process:
- C. The booster club shall submit a written request for approval in advance to the building principal, specifying the gift;
- D. Any gift with a value of more than \$200 per item or \$2,000 in aggregate, or any gift or donation which deals with modifications to school district buildings or grounds must be approved in advance by the board of education. Donations other than this must be approved in advance by the building principal who will notify the superintendent in writing, who will in turn notify the board of education;
- E. The gift must fit within the existing program of the board, relative to both use and replacement cost;
- F. Any gift must meet all applicable legal criteria, e.g., affirmative action and Title IX;
- G. Athletics contributions must meet the guidelines and requirements of the NJ State Interscholastic Athletic Association (NJSIAA);

A gift becomes the property of the board without any restrictions or contingencies.
