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BY-LAWS

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**SUBJECT: NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF BOARD OFFICERS**

Officers of the Board of Education shall be nominated and elected by the simple majority of the Board at its Annual Organizational Meeting for a term of one year. They will take their oath as officers at this meeting along with newly elected members.

The District Clerk shall administer and countersign the oath of office to newly-elected Board members. The oath shall conform to [Article XIII-1 of the New York State Constitution](#), and [Section 10 of the Public Officers Law](#). No new Board member shall be permitted to vote until he/she has taken the oath of office.

The elected officers of the Board of Education are:

- a) President;
- b) Vice-President.

The Board shall appoint and the District Clerk shall administer the oath of office to the following district officers for a period of one (1) year. These oaths may take place at a time and location other than the organizational meeting.

Superintendent                      District Treasurer

District Clerk                      Deputy Treasurer

No persons shall be refused office or be excluded from office because of age, religion, race, creed, color, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, marital status, economic status, political affiliation or belief, or disability.
