## AP Student/Parent Contract

Recognizing the benefits and the rigors of Advanced Placement (AP) courses, we, the undersigned, agree to follow through with our intention to participate in one or more of the AP classes offered at La Salle Prep for the academic school year.

An Advanced Placement (AP) course is a challenging learning experience that takes a full academic year. Participation in AP courses is the best possible preparation for success in college. A record of AP courses on a student's transcript is an indication of the student's commitment to rigorous academics.

The rigorous curriculum requires additional effort and homework on the part of the student. The pace of the class is faster, covering more content and in greater depth. Summer work may be required as a prerequisite to the AP class. Your decision to select AP courses should be based upon your individual ability, interests, and motivation.

Students wishing to participate in the AP courses are expected to make a yearlong commitment to each course selected. Since classes are built upon student requests students cannot simply drop an AP class second semester. A change of mind, lack of motivation, failure to obtain outside tutorial support, unsatisfactory academic performance, and or wanting an easier semester schedule, are not compelling circumstances to drop an AP course. Not doing the AP summer work will not be a reason that allows a student to drop an AP course.

To complete the registration process for Advanced Placement coursework, the following criteria must be met:

1. An understanding that Advanced Placement courses are yearlong and you are making a yearlong commitment.
2. An understanding that due to staffing and scheduling requirements we must hold you to your forecasting.
3. An understanding that AP classes are college level classes that require significant extra time outside of class.
