

## EPAF vs A-G Requirements

**EPAF:** Students must complete the required number of credits (with a grade of C or better) in each subject area in order to graduate from Executive Preparatory Academy of Finance.

**A-G:** Students must complete the required number of credits (with a grade of C or better) in each subject area in order to be eligible for admission to the University of California (UC) and/or California State University (CSU).
