## **NEW Substitute Teacher Orientation:**

Effective substitute teachers take the responsibility to ensure that the educational process is not interrupted when the regular teacher/paraprofessional is absent, and provide students with appropriate learning activities and experiences in the subject area as described in the lesson plans prepared by the classroom teacher.

**Qualifications:** Must have a High School Diploma (or GED) plus 30 hours of college or a Paraprofessional Certification

**Fingerprinting:** State law requires that all substitute teachers have their fingerprints complete prior to entering a classroom. The cost is approximately \$47. This is a one-time fee and process that is valid for any Texas school district.

**Pay Rate:** HS Diploma (or GED) plus 30 college hours = \$60 per day

College Degree = \$65 per day

Certified Teacher = \$80 per day
