STRATEGY 1

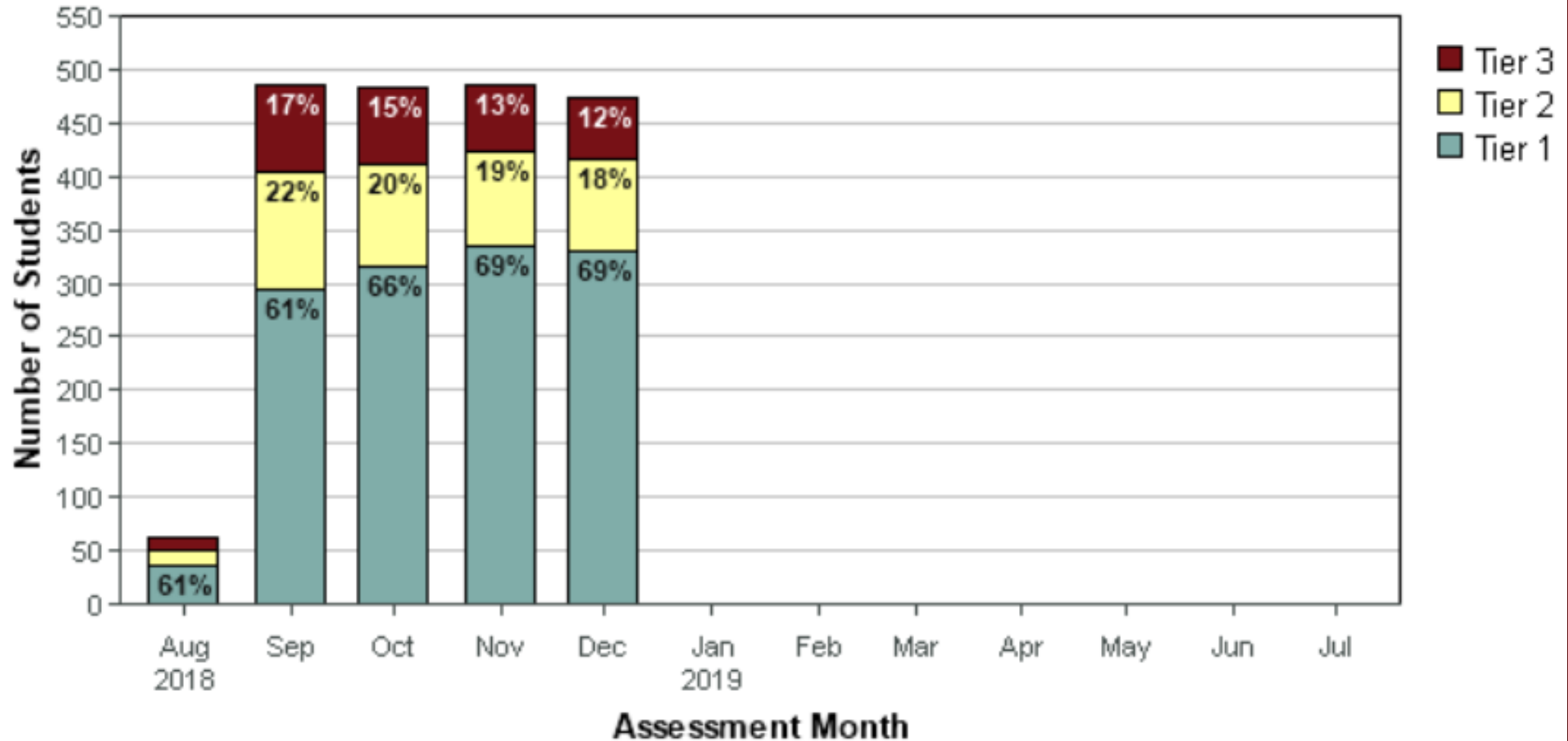

STRATEGY 2

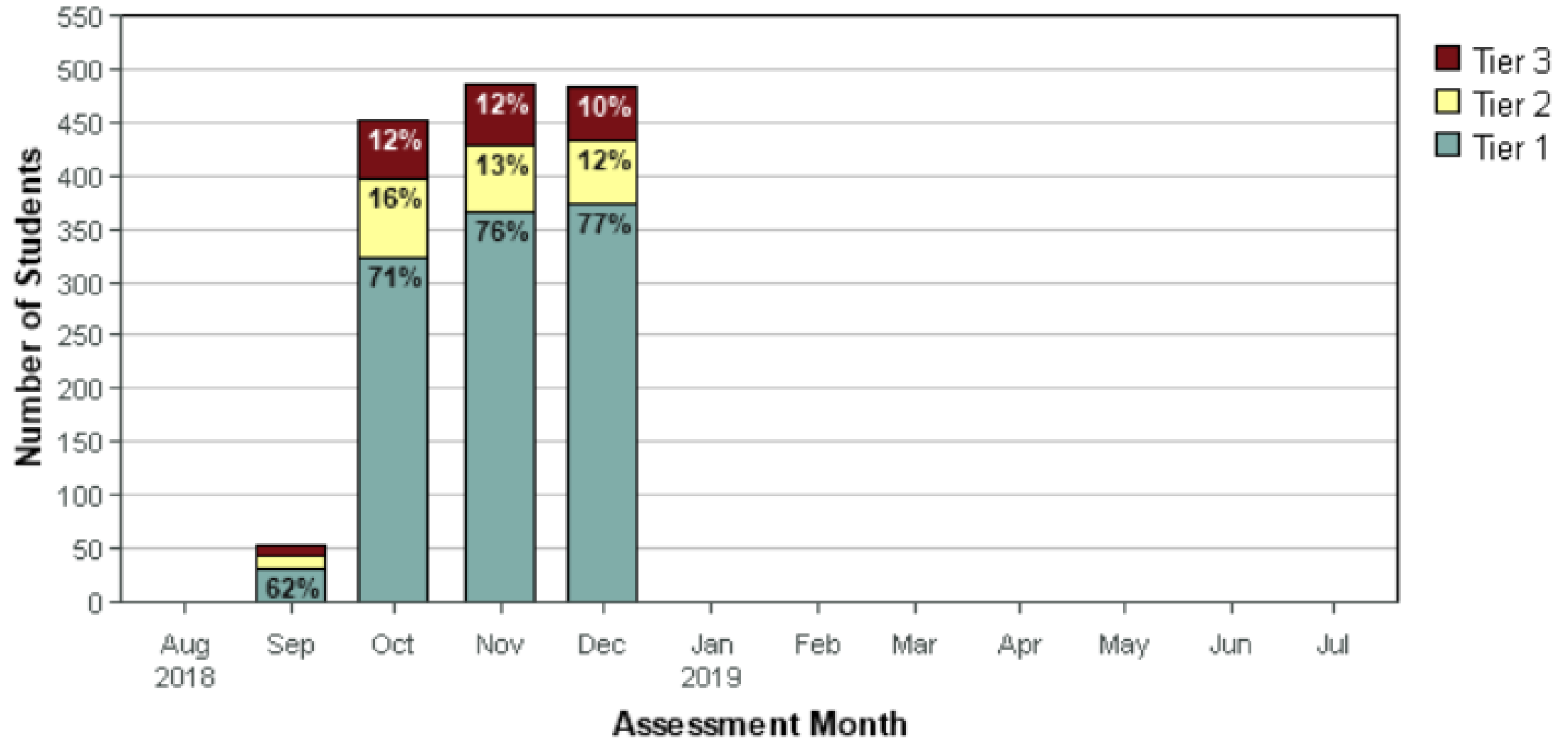
West Elementary School will develop and implement a classroom instructional model focused on student growth with coaching and guidance for all staff.
