2018 GALT JUHSD SUMMER BRIDGE PROGRAM

Course Descriptions

The Galt Joint Union High School District will be offering the following courses this summer for students that will be starting 9th grade in August. Students that apply for one of these courses must meet the qualifications as outlined in the course descriptions. Priority will be based first upon need of the student and then on the order in which applications were received.

Elevate (Math) 9

A summer acceleration program that provides instruction to incoming 9th grade students to build the knowledge and skills they need to be successful in Integrated Math I. The program is designed for students who have been placed in Math Foundations AND are identified as “nearly meeting standards” based on Math portion of the Smarter Balanced Assessments. At the end of this program, students will retake the High School Math Readiness test to see if their math skills have improved enough to be successful in Integrated Math I. If so, they will take Integrated Math I during their freshman year.

Math Foundations

A summer support program that provides instruction to incoming 9th grade students to help build their basic math skills. The program is designed for students who are identified as “not meeting standards” based on Math portion of the Smarter Balanced Assessments AND have been placed in Math Essentials or Math Foundations. At the end of this program, students will retake the High School Math Readiness test to see if their math skills have improved enough to be moved to the next level of math.

Reading (Language Live)

A summer acceleration program that provides instruction to incoming 9th grade students to help improve their reading skills. The program is designed for students who have been placed into Language Live. Upon successful completion of this program, students will retake the Reading Inventory to determine if they can be moved into the next level of English.

Writing Lab (English 3D)

A summer acceleration program that provides instruction to incoming 9th grade students to help improve their reading and writing skills. The program is designed for students who have been placed into English 3D. Upon successful completion of this program, students will retake the Reading Inventory to determine if they can be moved into the next level of English.

English Language Development

A summer program for English Language Learners to further improve their reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills in English to better prepare them to be successful in their academic classes during the regular school year.
