# WHAT COURSE SHOULD I TAKE?

## **PRINCIPLES OF LAW, PUBLIC SAFETY, CORRECTIONS, AND SECURITY**

1 Credit      Grades 9-12

**Prerequisites:** None

Principles of Law, Public Safety, Corrections, and Security introduces students to professions in law enforcement, security, corrections, and fire and emergency management services. Students will examine the roles and responsibilities of police, courts, corrections, private security, and protective agencies of fire and emergency services. The course provides students with an overview of the skills necessary for careers in law enforcement, fire service, security, and corrections.

## **PRINCIPLES OF GOVERNMENT & PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION**

1 Credit      Grades 9-12

Government and Public Administration introduces students to foundations of governmental functions and career opportunities within the United States. Students will examine governmental documents such

as the United States Constitution and the Bill of Rights.

## **LAW ENFORCEMENT I**

1 Credit      Grades 10-12

Law Enforcement I is an overview of the history, organization, and functions of local, state, and federal law enforcement. This course includes the role of constitutional law, the United States legal system, criminal law, law enforcement terminology, and the classification and elements of crime.

## **LAW ENFORCEMENT II**

1 Credit      Grades 11-12

Law Enforcement II provides the knowledge and skills necessary to prepare for a career in law enforcement. This course includes the ethical and legal responsibilities, operation of police and emergency telecommunication equipment, and courtroom testimony.

## **FIREFIGHTER I**

1 Credit      Grades 9-12

Firefighter I introduces students to firefighter safety and development. Students will analyze Texas Commission on Fire Protection

rules and regulations, proper incident reporting and records, proper use of personal protections equipment, and the principles of fire safety.

## **FIREFIGHTER II**

1 Credit      Grades 11-12

Firefighter II is the second in a series for students studying firefighter safety and development. Students will understand Texas Commission on Fire Protection rules and regulations, proper incident reporting and records, proper use of personal protections equipment, and the principles of fire safety. Students will use procedures for use of fire extinguishers, ladder, fire hose, and water supply apparatus.

## **PRACTICUM IN LAW, PUBLIC SAFETY, CORRECTIONS & SECURITY**

2 Credits      Grade 12

The Practicum is designed to give students supervised practical application of previously studied knowledge and skills.
