WHAT IS TITLE I

- A Federal Program that provides funds to schools to support education and minimize the effects of poverty.

WHY SHOULD I CARE ABOUT TITLE I?

- There are more than a half a million reasons.
- \$678,000.00 comes to PCSST this year
- What does that get us?
 - 4 Basic Skills Teachers
 - 1 Reading Specialist
 - 2 Instructional Coaches
 - A Credit Recovery Program
 - A Summer Reading Program
- Training for Teachers
 - 11 Days of Orientation
 - Attendance at the NJ Science Teachers Convention, The Math Teachers Convention, The Language Arts Teachers Convention, The Social Studies Teachers Convention.....
- PSAT Prep classes for students
- CCP program
- PASS+ Saturday Tutoring program
- Chromebooks
- Software to support student learning
- And more!

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO SUPPORT TITLE I?

- Complete school surveys in the Spring and Fall
- Attend PTO meetings and ask questions about programs
- Attend PCSST events
- Ensure that your children READ
- Get your children to school ON TIME & EVERY DAY
- Enroll your children in PCSST programs like CCP or PASS+

HOW DOES THE PARENTS RIGHT TO KNOW AFFECT ME?

- You have the Right to Know that your children are being taught by Highly Qualified Teachers who are Certified by the state of New Jersey in the content area they teach.
- If your child is taught by an un-certified teacher or a teacher who is not Highly Qualified in their content area, the school **MUST** notify you after 30 days.
 - EVERY TEACHER AT PCSST IS CERTIFIED AND HIGHLY QUALIFIED

WHAT IS THE PARENT SCHOOL COMPACT?

- The Compact is our agreement that PCSST will provide a high quality educational experience for your children and to engage you in the process.
- The Compact is your agreement to support the efforts of PCSST through your efforts at home to encourage your children to work toward the academic and behavioral goals of the school.
- The Compact is the students' agreement to put forth their best effort to achieve at high levels and maintain a positive school environment for everyone.
- This weekend you can make suggestions to amend the Compact and at our next PTO meeting the president and I will sign the Compact.
