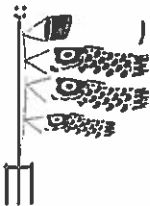
JAPANESE LANGUAGE SCHOOL

MCC traces its roots back to the late 1800's to the founding of a Japanese Language School. Today, children from all nationalities and backgrounds continue to learn the Japanese language and are exposed to the Japanese culture.



This program is open to children ages 5 to 12 years of age. Instruction consists of reading, writing and speaking. Japanese School will follow the DOE public school year calendar. Transportation is available from certain area schools. Space is limited.

Students with classes held during 2nd bell for Japanese School and who are transported to MCC by our vehicles must enroll in the After-School program.

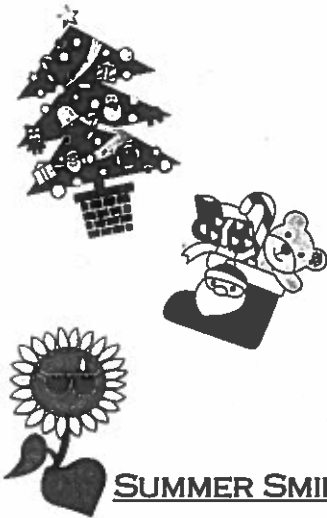

SUMMER SMILES PROGRAM

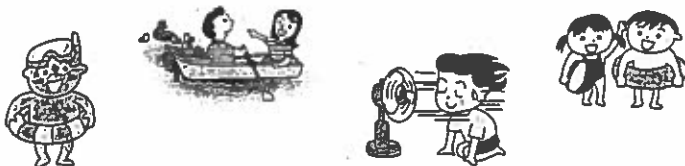

We offer various packages based on the types of programs area schools are planning to hold during the summer. Program hours are from 7:00 a.m.-5:30 p.m. daily. Half-day programs MAY be offered at MCC based on DOE schools in our area offering instructional summer programs.

Our summer program is designed to keep the children occupied with an array of activities including field trips, swimming, arts & crafts, cooking and much more. We will also implement simple curriculum activities to keep your child's mind stimulated during their break from school.
