Competition starts early Saturday with TSD Junior Varsity and Varsity Volleyball games at 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. against Brentwood Christian.

The 5:30 p.m. kick-off matches the TSD Rangers against the Cubs from California School for the Deaf-Riverside, with TSD's 2012-2013 Homecoming court revealed during half time activities.
