

**LYNWOOD UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
APPLICATION FOR CITIZENS' OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE**

The Board of Education of the Lynwood Unified School District is seeking qualified, interested individuals to serve on a committee of community leaders which will serve as the independent Citizens' Oversight Committee ("COC") for the implementation of the District's Measures K and N school facilities bond programs.

Proposition 39 Bond Election

The District has two Proposition 39 Bond Measures that were approved by voters. Both required a 55% supermajority for approval. On November 6, 2012, voters passed Measure K authorizing \$93 million in bonds. On November 8, 2016, voters passed Measure N authorizing \$65 million in bonds. Both programs provide funding for needed repairs, upgrades, and new construction projects to the District's schools.

Establishment of a Citizens' Oversight Committee

After a bond authorized under Proposition 39 is passed, state law requires that the Lynwood Unified School District Board of Education appoint a Citizens' Oversight Committee to work with the District.

Committee Responsibilities

In accordance with Education Code Section 15278(b), the Citizens' Oversight Committee shall:

- Inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of Measures K and N bond proceeds;
- Review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that Measures K and N bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Measures K and N; and
- Present to the Board of Education in public session, an annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of Measures K and N bond proceeds.

The Bylaws which govern the Citizens' Oversight Committee are attached to this Application.

Appointment of Committee Members

All appointments will be made by the Board of Education from applications submitted to the District.

Time Commitment and Term

Initial appointments will be staggered, such that some of the initial appointees will be appointed to serve one full two-year term. The other initial appointments will serve a one-year term, but will be eligible for reappointment by the Board of Education for a second two-year term.
