

SY18-19 Breakfast, Recess & Lunch –Pre-Payment/Debit Only

Radford High School uses HARRIS-E-Triton, a computerized pre-payment/debit system. Each student will be issued a personal photo ID with a barcode. If an ID is lost, students must secure a new ID for \$5.00 at the Transition Center Rm 113.

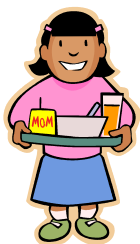
Cash and check deposits will be accepted at the office. Insert payment (preferably checks made out to “DOE – Lunch”) and print information on envelopes provided and deposit into drop box in the main office. On school days, it will take up to 24 hours for deposits to be processed.

Student lunch accounts can be managed online through www.ezschooldpay.com.

This will allow parents to:

- a) deposit money on the accounts, credited within 10 minutes.
- b) check student lunch account balances and transactions.
- c) set up low balance alerts on their devices through the mobile app.
- d) Make payments using Visa, Mastercard, Discover, AMEX and debit cards.

Note: A 2% service(convenience)fee will be charged for every deposit made.

Second & subsequent lunch	\$5.50

IMPORTANT:

Students who purchase meals for their friends will be paying the 2nd breakfast meal at FULL price listed above.

If the account doesn't have sufficient funds, the **2nd meal will not be served.**

Students are not permitted to loan their ID's to others.

RECESS is a mid-morning snack. ALL students, regardless of lunch eligibility (Free, Reduced or Paid) need to pay all items served at **regular price**.

Only **students with funds** in their accounts will be served during **RECESS**.
