

Title I District Level Parental Involvement Policy [Lucerne Valley Unified School District]

Lucerne Valley Unified School District has jointly developed a written Title I parental involvement policy with input from Title I parents. *Parent groups at both of our sites were able to have input into the policy.* It has distributed the policy to parents of Title I students. *The policy has been sent home with all students.* The policy describes the means for carrying out the following Title I parental involvement requirements [20 USC 6318 Section 1118(a)-(f) inclusive].

Involvement of Parents in the Title I Program

To involve parents in the Title I program at *Lucerne Valley Unified School District*, the following practices have been established:

- The schools convene an annual meeting to inform parents of Title I students about Title I requirements and about the right of parents to be involved in the Title I program.
** The programs will be discussed at Back to School nights.*
- The schools offer a flexible number of meetings for Title I parents, such as meetings in the morning or evening.
** Parents are invited to attend School Site Council Meetings, DELAC, ELAC, and other meetings hosted by administration.*
- The schools involve parents of Title I students in an organized, ongoing, and timely way, in the planning, review, and improvement of the school's Title I programs and the Title I parental involvement policy.
** The schools hold regular School Site Council Meetings to involve Title I parents.*
- The schools provide parents of Title I students with timely information about Title I programs.
** Title I programs are discussed at regular School Site Council Meetings.*
- The schools provide parents of Title I students with an explanation of the curriculum used at the school, the assessments used to measure student progress, and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet.
** Parent Teacher Conferences, Back to School Nights, and regular parent meetings allow for explanations of the above topics.*
- If requested by parents of Title I students, the schools provide opportunities for regular meetings that allow the parents to participate in decisions relating to the education of their children.
** Site administration is willing to schedule meetings to address decisions related to parents and students. Parents are also able to provide input through the LCAP process.*

School-Parent Compact

Lucerne Valley Unified School District distributes to parents of Title I students a school-parent compact. The compact, which has been jointly developed with parents, outlines how parents, the entire school staff, and students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement. With the assistance of Title I parents, the school educates staff members about the value of parent contributions, and in how to work with parents as equal partners.

** Staff meetings are held discussing strategies to engage parents.*

The school coordinates and integrates the Title I parental involvement program with other programs, and conducts other activities, such as parent resource centers, to encourage and support parents in more fully participating in the education of their children.

** Parental meetings are encouraged on topics including curriculum, instruction, and resources.*
