



Seniors now look ahead to college life

Four years at Molloy have been both challenging and fulfilling for the Class of 2015 but now it is time to move on to college.

Valedictorian Ewa Gerlak and Salutatorian Justin Esposito reflected on their time as Stanners but also looked ahead to the future in their speeches at Archbishop Molloy's 58th Commencement Exercises at Colden Auditorium at Queens College on June 6.

Gerlak was surprised to be named valedictorian "because there are people who deserved it more than I do and have worked harder."

She landed at the top of the class ranking due to her determination to do well because "whenever I don't do as well as I had hoped to do, I feel as if I have let myself down. So it motivates me to excel the next time because I know that I am capable of doing much more."

She also credits her classmates, who "have always supported me in one way or another to exceed my own expectations."

Gerlack was accepted by schools such as Cornell and NYU but chose to go to Binghamton University for

its "stellar academics, great extracurricular activities, and awesome school atmosphere."

Esposito also was surprised to be salutatorian, saying, "I knew I was in

the running for it but I definitely thought there were people with higher averages than me."

Esposito, after being accepted by Boston College and Boston Univer-

sity, chose to be part of the honors program at Fordham University because he was offered a full scholarship "and they really had everything I was looking for. The school is relatively close by and I really wanted to stay in the city. I've always loved living in New York City."

Most of Esposito's classmates have chosen to stay in the New York City area as well.

The most popular college choice was St. John's as 57 seniors will go there.

Sotiria Pateroulakis chose St. John's "because I was admitted into their pharmacy program, and aside from being a very good program, they gave me a generous scholarship that helped me make my decision."

Binghamton was the choice of 25 seniors followed by Hunter (18), Fordham (17), Adelphi (17), Stony Brook (14), and Queens (10).

Stanners are also going as far away as the Philippines, Ireland, Hawaii, and California.

Liana Liang is excited to be going to UCLA because it "has a gorgeous campus and I'm looking forward to studying outdoors in year-long summer weather. I'm just excited that I'll be able to live independently in a new

Lovelace & Yule win Curran Awards as top athletes

Alexandra Yule and Jared Lovelace were named winners of the Jack Curran Outstanding Senior Athlete Awards at the annual Sports Awards Night in the Jack Curran Gym on May 27.

Lovelace was a four-year varsity track and field athlete who won 20 individual CHSAA titles during his career.

He was a two-time state champion and named a meet Most Valuable Performer seven times.

Lovelace, whose best event was the triple jump, set three meet records during his career and his personal best jump of 50-feet-1.75-inches ranks second all-time in the CHSAA indoor

record book.

He was also member of Molloy's national qualifying shuttle hurdle relay team.

As a senior, he finished third at the Indoor High School National Track and Field Championships in the triple jump with a leap of 49-7.75 to earn High School All-America Honors.

He will continue his track and field career at the University of Wisconsin.

Yule was a three-year Varsity softball player who was team captain as a senior when she led her team to the CHSAA Brooklyn-Queens, City, and State titles.

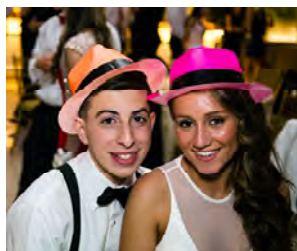

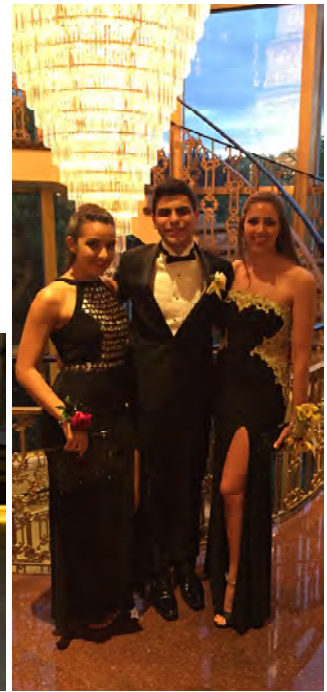

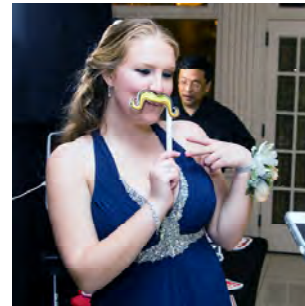
