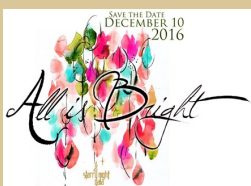
Thank you for helping us keep our eagles safe.

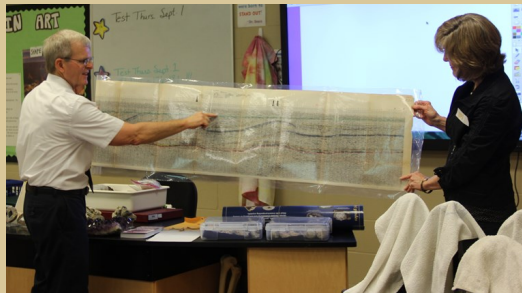
