

Call for Art

VSA Orange County Theme Art Contest: 2018 VSA Festival

Art work must be competed and delivered by November 16, 2017

Introduction

Special education students of all ages have the opportunity to create the official art design for the 2017 VSA Festival showcasing the artist accomplishments of people with disabilities. The winning art work will be reproduced in print materials, including flyers in the festival programs. The artist(s) will be recognized during the Opening Ceremonies of Orange County’s 42nd Festival, to be held April 21, 2018.

Contest Rules

1. Contest is open to all Orange County students in special-education classes.
2. Entries must reflect the theme: **“You’ve Gotta Have HeART”**
3. Size/Format: Entries must be between 9”x12” no larger than 18” x 24” in size.
Digital media must be created at 300 dpi.
4. Do not mat. Do not frame. Do not use glitter and other similar substances.
5. Art work with text will be disqualified if writing cannot be easily read and/or edited as needed.
6. Entries must be clearly marked for the identification. Completed Google entry form must be printed and attached to the back of the art work. Click [Google Entry Form](#) or go to <https://goo.gl/tuVs6Y> to complete the entry form.
7. Art work must be original and not infringe on any copyrights.
8. Entries must be received no later than November 16, 2017.

Theme: **“You’ve Gotta Have HeART”**

Media: Participants may utilize tempera, markers, crayons, or 2 dimensional media that will be colorful and reproduce well.
