### Not allowed in the stadium:

Weapons, Noise Makers, Illegal Drugs, Cans and Bottles, Umbrellas, Coolers, Fireworks, Outside Food and Beverages, Inflatable objects of any kind, Confetti, Balloons, Lasers, Poles and Sticks, Skateboards, Rollerblades, Bicycles, Animals (except service animals), or any item which may pose a health or safety issue to our guests and employees. All bags, jackets, guests, and vehicles are subject to search upon entering the premises.

Items like inflatables, big signs, sticks, umbrellas, etc... need to be left in the car, and cannot enter stadium turnstiles. No food leis will also be allowed in the stadium. Small types of seed, food, and candy leis will be allowed, but not the type with a string as a lei and holding a bag of chips or candy be allowed.

Only Hydroflasks that are 40 oz or smaller will be allowed in. No ice or liquids will be allowed in it. Concession will sell food and drinks.

## Graduate Information

### Dress Code for Graduation

#### Male:

2018 Cap and Gown from Balfour  
White dress short-sleeved collared shirt (no polo type)  
Solid black tie (no bow tie)  
Black dress shoes  
Black socks  
Black slacks only (no jeans allowed)

#### Female:

2018 Cap and Gown from Balfour  
Black dress (must be shorter than gown)  
Black top and skirt  
Black dress shoes (no heels higher than 2 inches)  
Black flats are fine, no flip flops allowed  
**\*\*When in doubt ask Mr. Goto for verification**  
**Outfit must abide by school dress code**  
(No strapless dress or tops allowed)

\*\*All dress code has been gone over prior to graduation and it is the graduates' responsibility to know and follow the rules. The dress code and rules will be strictly enforced.

- You must provide your own transportation to and from Aloha Stadium for practice and the ceremony on May 25th. The school will not provide transportation.
- Seniors will not be allowed back on campus after dismissal of Graduation practices on the 24th and 25<sup>th</sup>
- Stadium parking is free for the morning practice only. You will need to pay later for graduation.
- A current **Radford High School ID is mandatory at all practices**, including at the Stadium to get in
- **All cell phones will be confiscated upon check-in at Stadium on Graduation day**, (this is for the ceremony only not practice) you will not get it back until after graduation.
- Graduates check in at Aloha Stadium at 4:30pm at the ticket office
