Discussion regarding the timing of the NJASK student growth percentiles (still not available) and the manner in which it will affect summative ratings. Anthony Fitzpatrick noted that some districts are working with the other elements even for the tested areas.

Discussed point values for each rating category (ineffective, partially effective, effective, and highly effective): Mike Oliver noted some mathematical discrepancies and will be meeting with Jim Lymper to revise final summative point totals – revised forms will be sent to DEAC members for further comment prior to being introduced to district-wide faculty.
