Graduation:

You must pass English and Economics and any other grad requirement classes including credit recovery online work. Failing a class required to graduate will result in you not being allowed to walk at graduation, and you will have to attend summer school to get your diploma. It is crunch time – there is no more room for senioritis, procrastination, or excuses if you are struggling. If you are failing anything, talk to your teachers ASAP about how you can bring your grade up to passing. Remember there is open tutoring Tuesday and Thursdays in the library after school if you need help.

Also remember the Senior Policy about participating in graduation events. 10 or more tardies, 15 or more absences, 3 days of suspension during this semester, or six days of suspension during senior year are all things that can prevent you from attending the Senior Ball and Banquet and the Senior Picnic and walking at graduation.

address and student portal to-do list regularly – these are the only methods your school will use to contact you about financial aid forms and anything else they need from you.

Remember to accept your financial aid offer from your college, AND to log in to webgrants4students.org and confirm your school with CSAC so they know where to send your Cal Grant.
