

The Floresville ISD Education Foundation is pleased to announce the recipients of the 2016 Innovative Teaching Grants. In September, the Foundation announced that it would fund grants submitted by FISD teachers and administrators for a variety of innovative programs and projects to support higher levels of student learning. This year's funded grants will enhance student academic performance and support the objectives, goals, and initiative of the Campus Action Plan.

The Foundation received thirty-three applications from teachers and administrators at all school levels - elementary, middle, high school, and alternative involving more than 50 teachers.
