Fulcrum Scholarships

The Fulcrum Tuition Assistance Program is now open for St. Anthony School Families. Click on the link below to access the site (scroll down the page for the application).

For the Fulcrum Tuition Assistance Program:

- Applications are completed and submitted completely online.
- Nothing will be printed or signed and turned into the school.

Along with the application, each family must pay a \$24 fee to FACTS to apply for Fulcrum tuition assistance. If you have more than one child attending a Catholic school, only one

application and one fee is required. The deadline for submitting your application online is January 5, 2018. No Fulcrum Applications will be accepted or considered for funding after the deadline. The application is available in both English and Spanish.

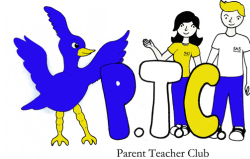

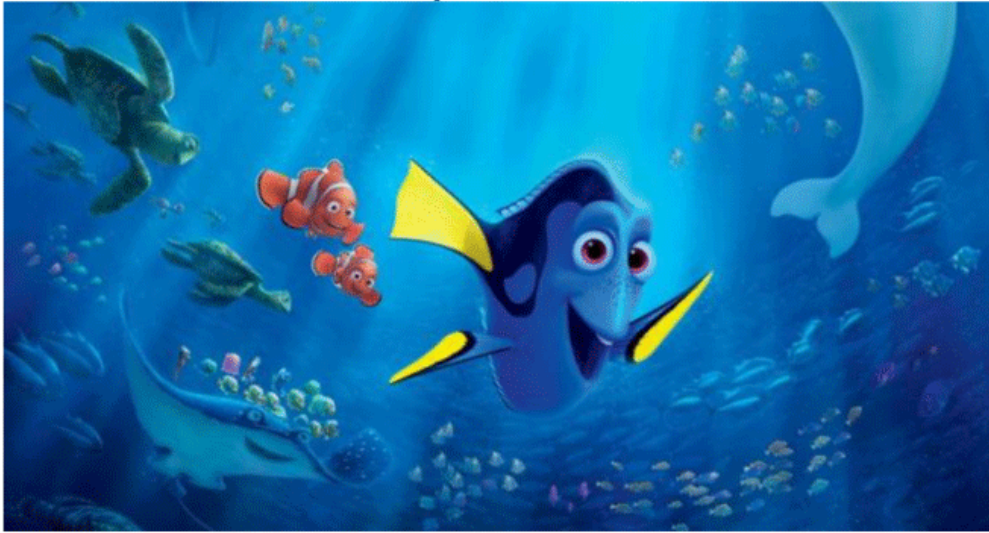
