Dear Parents and Students,

This is a reminder that applications for 2015 North Carolina Governor's School are currently available for **rising seniors only, with exceptions made for rising juniors in selected performing/visual arts areas**. The North Carolina Governor's School offers a unique residential experience to gifted and talented high school students. In efforts to make sure all parents are informed about the NC Governor's School Program, ECPS will be sending this information in this letter, on our Facebook page, District High School Program and Scholarship page and via Connect Ed call.

Students applying will need to be able to check off all the items below for consideration as one of the five ECPS North Carolina Governor's School Nominees. ECPS selected nominees will then be selected from a larger pool of candidates at the state level. Below are the eligibility requirements.

1. \_\_\_ Achievement Criteria: 92% -99% percentile ranges for:
  - overall/total composite score or
  - specific area composite/cluster score or
  - End-of-Course (EOC) score in appropriate area of nomination
2. \_\_\_ Legal NC resident at the time of attendance
3. \_\_\_ Presently enrolled in the 11<sup>th</sup> grade in NC Public School (exception noted above for 10<sup>th</sup> grade performing/visual arts candidates).
4. \_\_\_ Student is not a former Governor's School student

If all criteria above is met, please see your school guidance counselor for more information about this opportunity. When submitting the application additional materials are required such as two essays, an experience form, transcript and recommendations. All materials need to be submitted to your school guidance counselor by October 30, 2015 (**applications without all supporting materials will not be accepted**).
