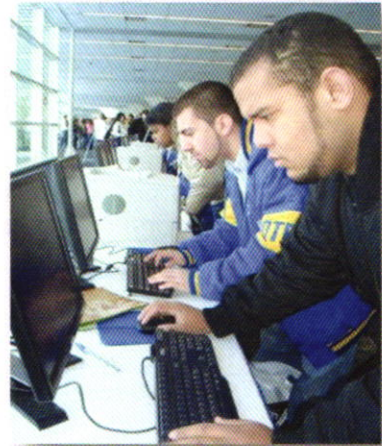

prior to attending the fair.

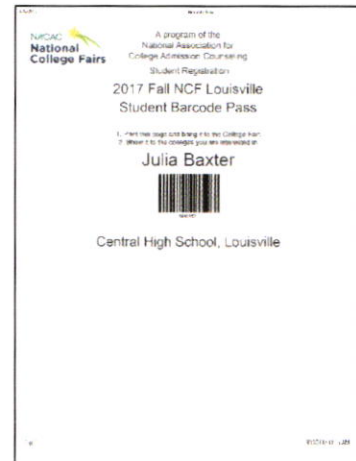
*Attendees will be asked a few short questions about their
