Registration Deadline Wednesday, March 28

If you miss this deadline – you will need to register for the Late Exams = \$45 late fee

What are AP Exams and Who Should Take Them?

AP Exams are to be taken by students who excel in a subject, would like to test their knowledge, want to stand out when applying to colleges and want to be prepared for college-level coursework. How much does it cost? Can I get a reduced fee?

Each AP Exam fee is \$94. You may qualify for reduced testing fees if you participate in the Free/Reduced Meal Program, Social Security Program, Medicaid Program or can provide a Parental Declaration of Income. You must contact Mr. Heinz for required documentation.

How do I register for an AP Exam?

- Fill out registration form indicating which tests you would like to take.
- Pay full amount \$94 (per test) or non-refundable registration fee of \$15 (per test) to Mrs. Lacy **BY WEDNESDAY, MARCH 28, 2018**.
- Unpaid balance of \$79 (per test) must be paid by **Friday, April 27, 2018** for admission to exam.
- After paying, submit the completed registration form to the Career Center.

Where does testing take place?

Testing takes place at PHS. Before the test date you will be notified of the location/classroom for your exam. You must show up 15 MINUTES EARLY to the testing location.

Late Testing: There are only a few exceptions for missing the scheduled AP Exam dates without paying a late fee. If you incur the **additional and non-refundable** \$45 Late Exam Fee, it must be paid at the time of registration.

You must notify Arianna Glick-Olmstead of your intent to test late by

MARCH 28, 2018 and write LATE next to any exam you plan to take at the later date on the registration form.

Late testing is allowed under the following circumstances:
