

Arthur B. Powell, associate professor and chair of the Department of Urban Education at Rutgers University-Newark, has authored or edited five books and published numerous articles. His research areas include ethnomathematics, critical mathematics, analysis of curriculum materials, Gattegno's subordination of teaching to learning in mathematics, and collaborative mathematical problem solving with technology. He created the non-profit organization, Elevating Learning above Teaching (ELAT), to support professional development projects around the ideas and materials of Dr. Caleb Gattegno for elementary school teachers in Haiti. In 2003, along with others, he co-founded the Bronx Charter School for Better Learning. There he conducts professional development workshops in for teachers in mathematics.
