Rules and Regulation

- Student and parent must complete the Student Parking Permit Request and the Pamlico County Schools Consent for Random Drug and Alcohol Testing Form
- Parking in the student parking area will require a visible cling-on parking permit **INSIDE driver's side windshield at bottom left.**
- Student vehicles must be parked in the student parking lot
- No parking in driveway or unauthorized areas will be allowed
- No littering in the parking lot
- No loitering in the parking lot
- All school fees and fines must be current.

Permit Cost

- \$35 payable in PCHS bookkeeper's office.

Parking Violations

- First Offense – Ticket with a \$5 fine
- Second Offense – Fine of \$5.00 and Vehicle Towed at Owner's Expense
- Third Offense – Fine of \$5.00 and Loss of Parking Privilege

The following offenses will result in LOSS of parking privileges: NO WARNING!!!

- Careless and reckless driving in the parking lot
- Found in possession of illegal drugs or alcohol on campus
- Found in possession of a weapon on campus
- Use of vehicle to skip school
- Taking another student off campus without permission

Pamlico County High School Parking Contract

Application:

- 1) "Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not of right. The school retains authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots and inspections of the exteriors of student automobiles on school property. The interiors of student vehicles may be inspected whenever a school authority has reasonable suspicion to believe that illegal or unauthorized materials are contained inside. Such patrols and inspections may be conducted without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant." (Board Policy 6600.3 Adopted: June 5, 2000 Revised: August 1, 2011).
- 2) All automobiles must be registered and must display a current parking permit hanging tag on rearview mirror. Parking permits will cost \$35.00 within the first week of the beginning of the school year. Replacement clinging tags will cost \$5.00. Only students with a valid driver's license and registration will qualify for a parking permit.
- 3) Students who do not display a parking permit will be ticketed and fined \$5.00. On the second offense, the vehicle will be towed at owner's expense in addition to the \$5.00 fine. Failure to register the car within two weeks will result in paying both the registration fee and the fine. A third offense will result in a loss of parking privilege.
- 4) Students with a registered vehicle and a parking permit tag properly displayed will be allowed to park in the parking lots designated for students. Failure to follow this rule will result in suspension of parking privileges.
- 5) Students may not sell trade or loan parking permits. This action will result in the loss of parking privileges for the year for both parties involved. If a student does not have current parking privileges they may lose parking privileges for the following school year.
- 6) Failure to drive appropriately on school property may result in the loss of parking privileges (speed limit is 5 miles per hour in all high school parking lots).
- 7) Students are not permitted to go to their cars during the school day without the permission of an administrator. Students may not loiter in the parking lots before or after school.
- 8) The administration will investigate violations of school rules involving the parking lots and/or automobiles including requiring students to show all of the contents of the automobile whenever a school official has reasonable grounds to believe that illegal or unauthorized materials are contained inside.
- 9) Students are to exit their vehicle and report to the school building at 7:30 a.m. Any student that arrives to school past 8:00 a.m. or leaves and returns to campus during school hours, must park in the student parking lot and sign in at the front office and obtain a pass to class.

I agree to abide by the above parking lot regulations at Pamlico County High School while parking a vehicle on campus. I understand that the failure to comply with said regulations may result in loss of parking permits and that registration fees will not be refunded if parking privileges are revoked. I have also read and understand the consequences for parking lot violations included in the Pamlico County High School Student Parking Permit Request Form.
