### MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION AT SCHOOL

Dear Parent/Guardian:

The safety and good health of your child is important to us. Healthy children learn better. Please obtain the necessary information and signatures and return the completed forms and medications to the school health office before the first day of the school year.

In order for school personnel to assist a student with medication at school the law requires that the medication is in a labeled container with the child's name, physician's name, medication name, dosage, and expiration date. The law also requires a medication form be completed including physician and parent signatures. This includes non-prescription (over the counter) medications (Education Code 49423). **No "over the counter" medicine will be given without doctor's and parent's signature on the "medication administration at school" form.**

Medications should be taken at home whenever possible. **The first dose of any medication must be given at home to ensure the student does not have a negative reaction.**

Please see the Snowline School District Web site, under the "Special Services" department for Health Services and the medication administration form (<http://www.snowlineschools.com>). Or you may pick one up at the school's health office. Remember that both sides must be completed, one side completed by the doctor, the other side, the parent.

**Please save the medication form** and take it with you when your child visits the doctor. The medication form must be renewed each school year or if there are any changes made to your child's medication orders. If you have any questions, please call the District School Nurse at 868-5805.
