Any 10th, 11th or 12th grader who would like to take this very important career aptitude test may sign up now in the counseling office. The ASVAB is one of the most common tests for high school students to take to help identify their career interests and abilities. The test is free and open to all students, whether they are planning on entering the military or not. For students who do enlist in the military after high school, 11th and 12th grade scores on the ASVAB can be used to qualify for various careers while serving in the armed services.
