



Selection Process for *The Collegiate School of Memphis* Middle School Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society

The purpose of this chapter of the National Junior Honor Society is to create enthusiasm for scholarship, to stimulate a desire to render service, to promote worthy leadership and citizenship, and to encourage the development of character in scholars.

This chapter operates under the direction of and in full compliance with the NJHS National Constitution, and has been given full authority to identify eligible candidates, select members, and administer chapter activities.

Membership Selection

- Membership in this chapter is an honor bestowed upon deserving students by the faculty and shall be based on the criteria of Scholarship, Service, Leadership, Citizenship, and Character.
- Candidates eligible for selection to this chapter must be in the second semester of the sixth grade or members of the seventh or eighth grade class.
- To be eligible for selection to membership in this chapter, the candidate must have been enrolled for a period equivalent to one semester at *The Collegiate School of Memphis*.
- Candidates eligible for selection to the chapter shall have a minimum 1st semester cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. Sixth grade students' cumulative grade point averages will include only their 1st semester grades, while 7th and 8th grade cumulative grade point averages will include their previous 6th and 7th grade 1st and 2nd semester averages attained at *The Collegiate School of Memphis*.
- Upon meeting the grade level, enrollment, and GPA requirements, candidates shall then be considered based on their service, leadership, citizenship, and character. The selection of each member to the chapter will be based on a majority vote of the Faculty Council.
