Richland High School in conjunction with Brant's Driving School will conduct Driver's Training (Theory & Behind-the-Wheel). The driving portion will be available to those students who have successfully completed the classroom portion of the driver's education course either in a prior class or the on-line course. These are the only students who qualify to sign up for the driving portion for this summer.

The program will be as follows:

Theory for Grades 9 -12

Theory is an on-line course.

Behind-the-Wheel Instruction for Grades 9-12

*Automobile Schedule – as scheduled by the instructor on an individual basis.
You must have the classroom portion completed prior to doing the driving portion.
You must have your permit or license in order to do the driving portion.*

***Registration Fee Student - \$150.00
(Includes both the Theory & Behind-the-Wheel)***

Payment will be required at the first lesson/prior to registration and can be in the form of check (payable to Brant's Driving School), cash or credit card (VISA or MasterCard).

Other Important Information:

- ▶ You **MUST** have the **Driver Education On-Line Course** completed prior to being eligible for automobile instruction.
- ▶ If you are a senior and have not completed the driving portion yet, you can still sign up and must get all 6 hours of your driving completed by June 30, 2012.
- ▶ Behind-the-wheel lessons will be scheduled according to the student's availability. Evenings and weekends are available.
