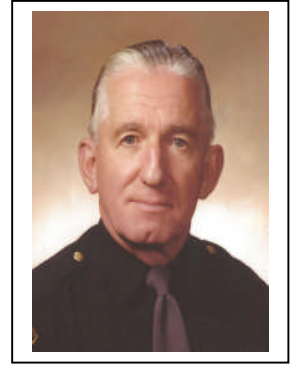


EDWIN H. CUNNINGHAM
