The Interact Club of Loomis Basin Charter School is a service club for MYP Students and is part of Rotary International, the world's first service club organization. Individual Rotary clubs sponsor the youth component, Interact clubs, by providing guidance and support. Our club is supported by the Rotary Club of Loomis Sunset. School parents Angelo Theodorou and Sara Thornros are mentors for our school club. The first Interact club was founded in 1962.

Our school club is having its first meeting of the 2015/16 school year on **Monday September 21st. We meet at 3:15 to 4:15pm in the school library, every other Monday.** The club is extending an invitation to all MYP students at LBCS to come and see what we do.

Below is a brief summary of who we are and some of the service projects we have completed in our local community and internationally.

- The LBCS Interact Club is a self-supporting, self-governing club with minimal direction and financial support from the Rotary Club of Loomis Sunset – who mentor the club – our club is 2 years old
- The LBCS Club designed and constructed the large sign you see at the entrance to the school campus
- The LBCS Club has performed several cleanup projects on our school campus and around the Town of Loomis
- The LBCS Club has participated with the Rotary Club of Loomis Sunset in feeding the senior community at the Methodist Church on Brace Road – this is a bi-annual project
- The LBCS Club has donated over 2,500 to the global cause of eradicating Polio – in-fact our small club won the District 5180 competition this year, by raising over 1,800 dollars for Polio – they won a suite at a River Cats game. A huge accolade for our club, as we are only one of 2 Middle School Clubs in the district – all other clubs are at the High School level
