

SAT ---- New Score Structure --- Starting with the March 2016 SAT.

Scores on the redesigned SAT can provide deep insight into student college readiness. The more robust data now include two cross-test scores and seven subscores that show how students tested in specific skill and knowledge areas.

Score Summary

- One composite score ** Total Score – Scale score, 400-1600
- Two section scores ** Evidenced-Based Reading and Writing & Math – Scale, 200 – 800
- Three test scores ** Reading & Writing and Language & Math – Scale 10 – 40
- Two cross-test scores ** Analysis in Science & History/Social Studies – Scale 10 – 40
- Seven subscores ** Scale 1 – 15
