

### 6150 - Tuition Income

The Board of Education shall charge and assess tuition for attendance in the schools of this district by pupils not entitled to receive a free public education in this district and whose enrollment has been approved by the Board.

Millburn Board of Education does not have a regular pupil receiving relationship with any other Board of Education.

When non-resident pupils attend classes in Millburn Township Public Schools, the cost of such attendance shall be assessed as follows:

1. Special Education

The rates for each school year shall represent the special education program costs for programs operated by Millburn Township Public Schools as a member of the Morris-Union Jointure Commission and shall be computed in accordance with a Jointure Commission formula developed and approved by the membership. Such program costs shall be determined on or about October 15th of the school year for which the rates apply.

2. Other Non-Resident Pupils

The rates for each grade level organization (K-5, 6-8, 9-12) shall be based on the "Per Pupil Costs for Tuition Purposes" as prescribed by the State Department of Education formula and as reported in the Board Secretary's Annual A4-1 Report for the immediately preceding school year. Such rates shall be adjusted on or about September 1st of the school year for which the rates apply so as to reflect current enrollment data.
