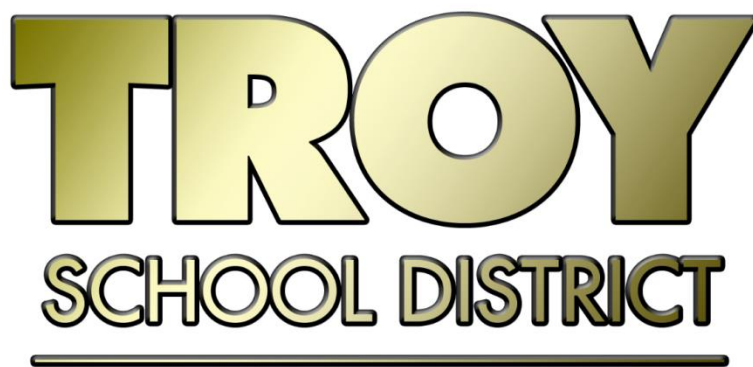


WAIVING A COURSE REQUIREMENT BY TESTING OUT

WAIVING A COURSE THROUGH TESTING OUT PARENT/STUDENT INFORMATION SHEET

1. Information will be available throughout the year. The information will consist of this Parent/Student Information Sheet and the information on specific tests.
2. Students will be tested on their knowledge of the course expectations specific to the Troy School District courses and expectations.
3. Successful performance on the exam (minimum of 77%) allows a student to be placed in the next level.
4. Successful performance on the assessment (at least a 77%) will be noted on the student's transcript. No record will be seen on the transcript if the student does not pass.
5. Courses tested out of will be accepted as fulfillment of a requirement in a course sequence.
6. Courses tested out of will not count in the computation of the student grade point average, but students will receive course credit. Students are still required to carry a full course/credit load.
7. Students wishing to waive a class must complete the "Waiving a Course Through Testing Out Authorization and Notification Form" and submit it to the principal by the deadline on the application.
8. Test sessions will be limited to four hours (there may be more than one testing session).
9. **Tests will be scheduled for April, May, and the first week of June.** The principals, in consultation with other administrators and teachers, will determine dates for the exams. The math testing date is set by the district. Students who cannot test on that date must notify their building principal in writing prior to the testing date and a make-up session will be scheduled.
10. Tests to opt out of a class will only be given in **April/May/June**. There will be no exceptions.
11. For middle school students taking a test for a class that is offered at the middle school, the test will be given at the middle school. All other tests will be given at the high school (or a specified location in the district).
12. Middle school principals will contact the high school principals to indicate the number of students and the courses for which they wish to be tested.
13. For tests that require their use, the department will designate the use and type of calculators. Memory will be cleared before and after the exam.
14. Per current state law, students can attempt to test out of any courses, even high school Government and Civics.
15. Students will be notified of their test results within a reasonable time. Results will be reported as pass/fail. Tests are secure and are not returned for review.

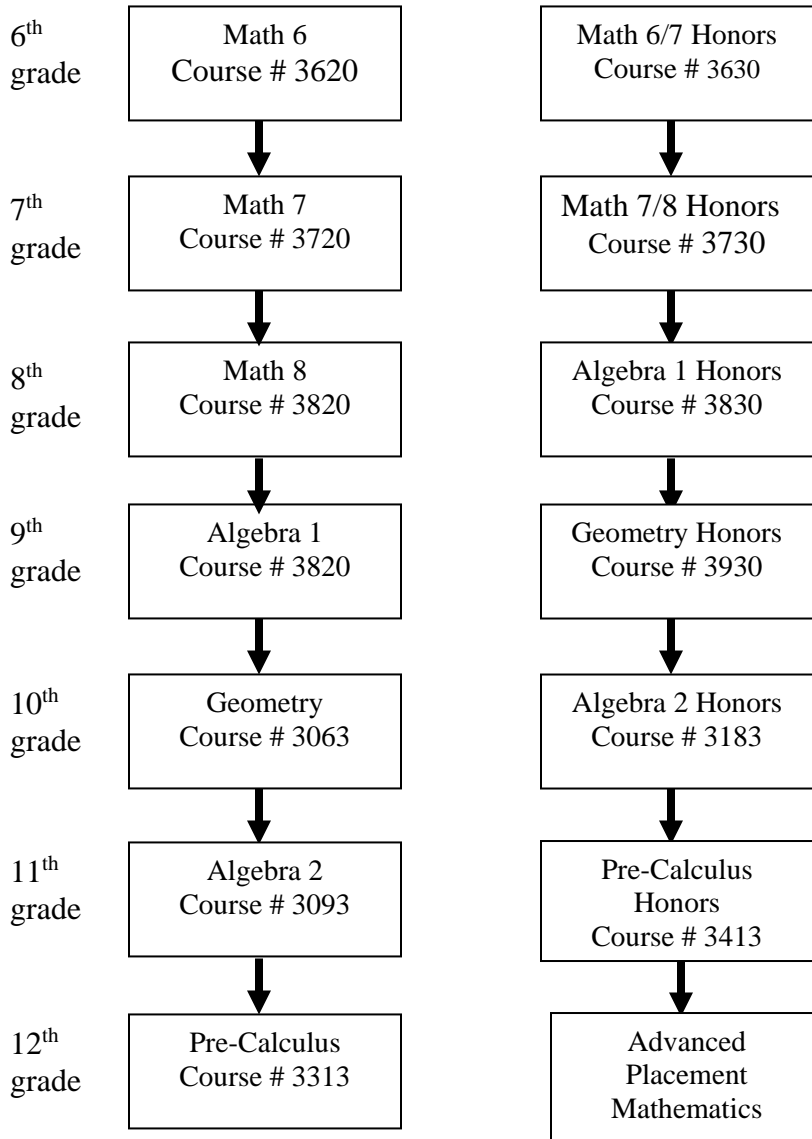

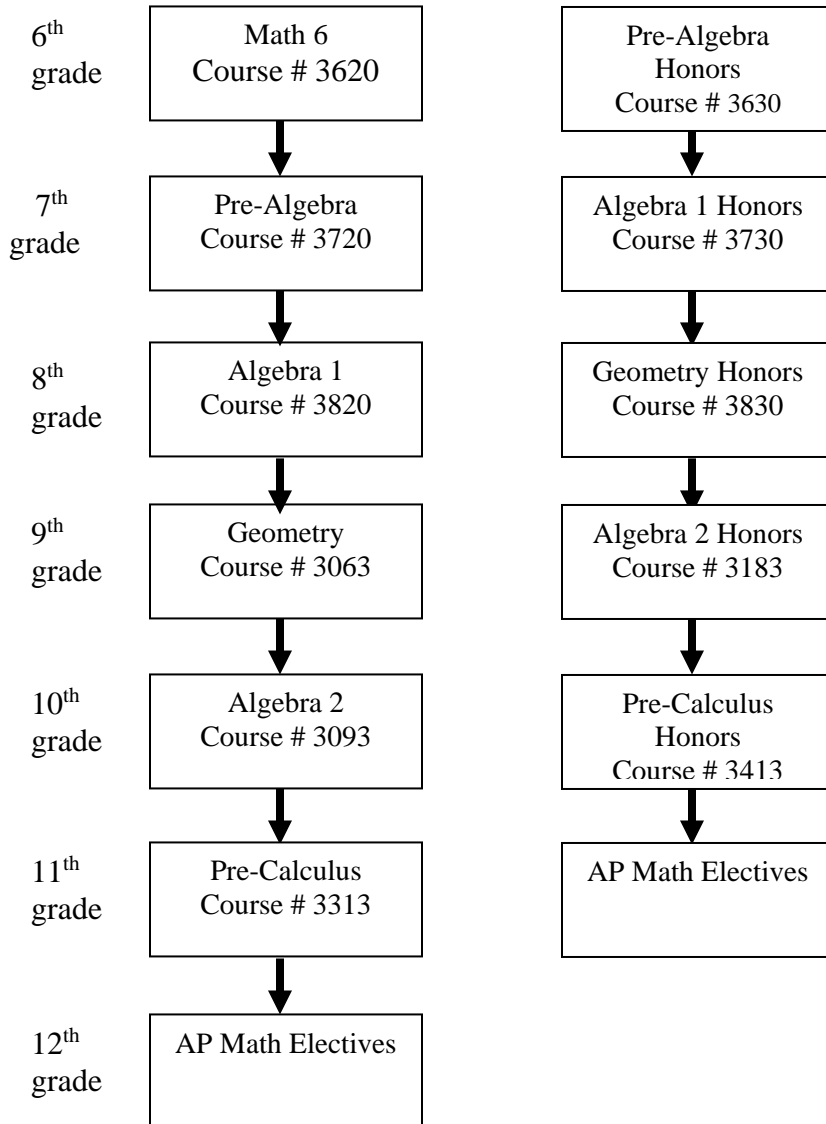
