**8th Grade Students will report immediately to their Homeroom at 8:00 am. INELIGIBLE STUDENTS WILL NOT ATTEND THE AUDUBON CULMINATION!

Following the Culmination Ceremony (Recessional) – $ALL\ 8^{th}$ grade students will proceed in the recessional to their homeroom, where they will receive their actual Middle School Culmination Certificate. Students will be released by 11:15 am.

Graduation Tickets

1. On Friday, May 30, **five (5) graduation tickets** will be given to each <u>ELIGIBLE</u> 8th grade student as their names are called during the mandatory rehearsal. Extra tickets (if available) will be distributed after rehearsal on Monday, June 2, 2014.

REHEARSAL (Mandatory)

- 1. ALL STUDENTS MUST ATTEND THE COMPLETE REHEARSAL AND BEHAVE APPROPRIATELY IN ORDER TO PARICIPATE IN THE GRADUATION CEREMONY.
- 2. Rehearsal information:
 - a. Monday, June 2 and Tuesday, June 3, 2014
 - b. 8:30am Until we get it right!
 - c. Location: Audubon Auditorium and Audubon Field.

SPEAKER / SINGER TRYOUTS

Audubon Graduation Speaker Tryouts will take place on Thursday, May 29, 2014 in the library during 4. Graduation Speakers will be announced on Friday, May 30, 2014.

2014 Culmination Requirements:

- Signed ICP FORM Signed by Parent in the
- Counseling Office
- Students must pass a minimum of 10 classes in the eighth grade year.
- A Passing grade of A, B, C, or D as the final academic mark earn 50 credits
- PASS English 8 and Math Class (Algebra 1, Geometry, or Algebra Readiness)
- No MORE than 2 U's in COOPERATION / No MORE than 2 U's in Work Habits
- 95 % ATTENDANCE Rate NO MORE THAN 10 ABSENCES for the year.

NON CULMINATING STUDENTS/ Ineligible 8th graders

Students who are NOT ELIGIBLE to participate in Culmination will report to school and remain in a designated classroom during the ceremony. Ineligible 8th grade students **WILL NOT** be allowed to attend nor participate in the culmination ceremony. In order to receive their certificate of promotion, needed for high school enrollment, they will HAVE TO PAY ALL outstanding balances due Audubon Middle School for lost/damaged textbooks, library fines, or PE uniforms.

Culmination Appeals and Delinquencies – Turn Over

APPEAL Committee:

- 1. Students will have an opportunity to appeal their eligibility for participation in the culmination ceremony by scheduling an appointment –Students who wish to have Appeal appointment MUST bring their parent/guardian and valid documentation that supports their appeal.
- 2. EACH APPEAL will last 15 minutes for student and parent to state their appeal before the committee.
- 3. Appeals will only be accepted for the following:
 - a. **ATTENDANCE**: 8th grade students who have not met the 95% attendance rate for the school year
 - b. **COMMUNITY SERVICE:** 8th grade students who have not met the required 20 hours of service.

NO APPEALS will be granted for ACADEMIC GRADES and failure to meet the LAUSD requirements.

AUDUBON SCHOOL DELINQUENCIES/ FINES/ FEES

- 1. If your name appears on any delinquency list (stop clearance), you may not participate in rehearsal or the culmination ceremony until it is cleared.
- 2. NO REHEARSAL = NO CEREMONY.
- 3. A Textbook Delinquency list is available in the textbook room. Letters will be mailed home to all 8th grade students if they owe for a lost or non-returned textbook.
- 4. A Library Delinquency list is available in the Library. Letters were mailed home to all 8th grade students if they owe for a lost or non-returned library book.
- 5. ALL 8th grade Textbooks are DUE and will be collected by June 2.
- 6. 8th grade students are expected to complete:
 - a. 8th Grade Handbook / Matriculation Form Due THURSDAY, MAY 29, 2014
 - b. Clearance Form signed by all appropriate offices DUE DATE: Friday, May 30, 2014
 - c. Service Hours Due Friday, May 30, 2014

- What High School and College you want to go to and why?
- How you plan to prepare for college in high school and explain what you will change about your study, or learning habits to better prepare yourself for college.
