## GRADING SYSTEM

The marking system is based on a 4.0 scale. Plus or minus marks are not computed. Advanced Placement courses as well as English 3H, Vietnamese 4H, and Latin 4H receive one extra grade point if the grade earned is a C or above. A ninth grade through twelfth grade class rank and a tenth grade through twelfth grade class rank are calculated. Rankings are based on a weighted GPA. Presently, GGHS offers 23 Advanced Placement courses and three honors courses.

## GARDEN GROVE HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE 2017 – 2018

Garden Grove High School is one of seven comprehensive high schools in the Garden Grove Unified School District. An urban school district with a total enrollment of more than 48,000 students, GGUSD is the 14<sup>th</sup> largest school district in California and the 92<sup>nd</sup> largest school district in the nation.

Garden Grove High School serves students from the cities of Anaheim, Garden Grove, Santa Ana and Westminster. The total enrollment for Garden Grove High School is 2,342 students. A culturally diverse community, GGHS has a student population that is 39.9% Hispanic, 27% Asian, 4.7% Caucasian, 25.5% Undefined, 1% African American, 2% Filipino and Pacific Islander and less than 1% Indian/Alaskan. The percentage of students who receive free or reduced-price lunches is 70%.

### CLASS OF 2017

In the class of 2017, there were 591 graduates. Twenty-seven percent of the class of 2017 chose to attend a four-year college, while sixty-four percent chose to attend a two-year college or vocational program. Graduates of the Class of 2017 are attending prestigious universities that include Duke, Harvard, Yale, University of Southern California, University of California, Davis and University of California, Los Angeles.
