

AMS Back-to-school FAQs

Q: What time can my child access the campus?

A: Students can access Adams as early as 7:30 am. We encourage them to come early on the first day in order receive their final schedule.

Q: Will we be able to access the school from multiple entryways?

A: Yes, students can be dropped off in front of the school off of Ripley and at the rear of the campus off of 182nd Street.

Q: What is the schedule for the first day of school?

A: Students will see all teachers on this day (stacked), but we will operate under normal school hours of 8:00 am - 2:50 pm.

Q: If my child is not registered, what should I do?

A: Complete the online registration and please visit the front office as early as 7:30 a.m. to ensure the process has been completed.

Q: Where will my child pick up his/her final schedule?

A: There will be areas designated for students to pick up their schedule before school begins:

- 8th grade in the library
- 7th grade in the quad
- 6th grade in the cafeteria

Q: Will students dress for PE on the first day of school?

A: No, students will not be required to dress for the first day and possibly the first couple of days.

Q: How should students' names be written on PE clothing?

A: Student names should be written first and last name OR first name and last initial and as large as the box will allow so teachers can see it.

Q: Will my child need to bring his/her instrument on the first day?

A: No, band students do not need to bring their instruments on the first day of school.

Q: Will my child need his/her Chromebook on the first day of school?

A: Yes, teachers may have activities planned that will require them to use their devices.

Q: Can my child bring his/her own lunch?

A: Yes, similar to elementary school, students are encouraged to pack their own lunch if they so choose.
