## ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

### Student Review

# MCA Behavioral Expectations

## Field Experiences

There will be several opportunities for students to take part in supplemental off-campus field learning.

- In order to participate in a field trip, students must obtain approval and make-up work from all of their teachers *PRIOR TO* the date of the field trip.
- Students will also be required to wear appropriate attire on all field trips.
- If a student fails to show up for a scheduled field trip without giving notice to Ms. Dexter in advance, he/she will be excluded from all field trips for at least one semester.

Upon entering all technical and English classes, MCA students and parents will sign contracts that establish responsibility for media lab and equipment use. Any disregard of specific agreement will prevent student from continuing in the MCA and parent/guardian will be responsible for any damage to equipment.
