We are looking at reducing the elementary school teachers, this does not mean it will happen, it's a budgetary plan, it doesn't mean we will cut school counselors. But I do not see cutting the Deans and filling Vice Principal positions. Adult Education speakers, there is nothing more happy to my heart than to hear ESL community members say - God bless America!

Jackie Ashe

- Thanked all those that came out. It's important to the community to get a better education and to lead wonderful lives. I don't believe in cutting teachers, and class size reductions. I admire you for coming tonight.

Jesus M. Holquin

- Thanked the speakers for coming and speaking on behalf of Adult Education. I am proud to be a product of Adult Education, that's how I learned my English. It's unfortunate that we need to discuss these issues, the actions in the State and the Federal level don't solve the budget problem, and there will be more action to be taken in order to balance the budget.
