

LVS PLAYGROUND RULES

1. Students will use Bulldog P.O.W.E.R. on the playground

- a. **P**ositive Attitude students will use kind words.
- b. **O**wnership students will not leave personal items at the playground.
- c. **W**ork Ethic students will take care of the balls and other equipment.
- d. **E**xcellence students will be safe and help each other.
- e. **R**espect students will be respectful to staff and other students.

2. Monkey bars

- a. 1st grade, student must be able to reach the first rung from the standing position on the top bar.
- b. Use the middle of the bars only.
- c. One person and one direction at a time.
- d. Other students must go around the Monkey Bars while in use.

3. Swings

- a. 60 second count per person.
- b. No count backs on the same person.
- c. Stand behind the designated area while counting.
- d. Swing straight only.
- e. No jumping off the swings.

4. Big toy (play structure)

- a. No balls on Big Toy
- b. No running on Big Toy
- c. No tag on the Big Toy
- d. Down the slides only
- e. No standing or sitting on the Big Toy side rails

All rules listed and new rules are at the discretion of Playground staff, Supervising Adults, and Administration for the purpose of maintaining a clean and safe playground for all students.

LVS PLAYGROUND RULES

5. Ball play

- a. Ball play in designated areas.
- b. Not in the wood chips or Big Toy.

6. Personal Belongings

- a. Pick up all personal Belongings (jackets, lunch bags, extra clothing, etc.)
- b. No trading of toys, cards, or other personal items at school.

7. Running

- a. Running on fields.
- b. No running on the black top.
- c. No running on wood chips.
- d. No running to or from line areas.

8. Food on playground

- a. Food is not permitted on the playground.

9. Time out area

- a. Student will report to the timeout area as directed by staff.
- b. Other students will not talk to students in timeout area.

10. Physical Contact

- a. Rough housing or dangerous play is not permitted.
- b. Physical contact should be kept to a minimum.
- c. Accidental physical contact should result in apology and assisting peer.
- d. No playing guns or violent type games with your hands.
- e. No play fighting.
