ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB GUIDELINES

a. Role of the Club

Temescal Canyon Athletic Booster Clubs exist as organizations of parents and community persons dedicated to:

- 1) Supporting, encouraging and advancing** the athletic programs and related activities of Temescal Canyon High School, thereby cultivating clean, wholesome school spirit, promoting good sportsmanship, and developing high ideals of character.
- 2) The clubs shall promote** projects to improve facilities and equipment necessary to provide an adequate athletic program for students of Temescal Canyon High School.
- 3) The clubs shall not seek to influence or direct** the technical activities or policies of the school administration or of the school officials who are charged with the responsibility of conducting the athletic programs of the schools of the district.
- 4) The clubs shall not seek to influence or direct** decisions of the coaching staff in regard to team personnel, game strategy, scheduling, team attire/uniforms or any other area over which the coaches have been given responsibility by the school administration. **The club shall do nothing** which violates the rules of the CIF Southern Section or in any way jeopardizes the membership of the school in said athletic association.

If at any time a booster club fails to adhere to the above guidelines the Principal, Athletic Director, and Head coach, separately or collectively, may elect to cease to recognize the club. At such time the booster club will no longer have any connection with the school or the school team. The booster club would also forfeit use of the school name or school mascot name as part of its booster club title.

b. Financial/Fundraising

A primary function of booster clubs each year often involves raising funds to supplement those provided by LEUSD for the operation of athletic programs. Traditionally, monies of the booster clubs are expended for such things as 1) improvement of the athletic facilities, 2) purchases of equipment used by the teams, 3) uniforms and warm-ups, 4) team travel gear, 5) banquets and awards, 6) team dinners. All purchases by the booster club are subject to approval by the head coach and/ or the Athletic Director.

*The Varsity head coach of each sport is responsible for obtaining signature approval for all booster club fundraising activities. This would include any information (flyers, website notices) disseminated to parents and community regarding fundraising.

c. Booster Club and Coaches

Individual sport booster clubs will be under the sponsorship of the Head Coach. Head coaches or their designee will attend all booster club meetings. Coaches will keep booster clubs informed of program goals and needs in an effort to facilitate and direct booster clubs in their efforts to support the program.

d. LEUSD and Boosters

All booster clubs and their activities shall be in accordance with requirements for operation as outlined in the LEUSD administrative regulations and Board Policy 1230.
